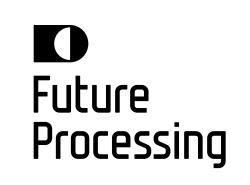
Future Processing's logo consists of a symbol and a logotype in either black or white colour. There are two versions of the logo: a horizontal and a vertical one. The default and preferred version of the logo is the horizontal version. The vertical version should only be used in special cases (i.e. if the legibility of the full logo is compromised [see example on page 6])

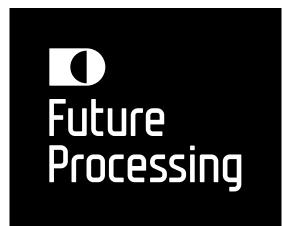

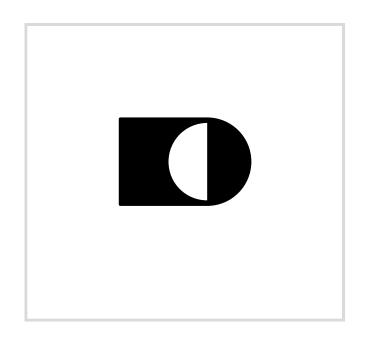


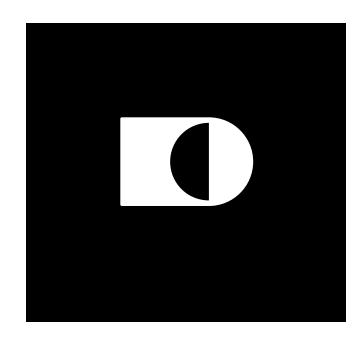




The symbol alone should only be used if the name of the company is already placed near the symbol, or if inserting the complete logo is not possible. Examples of such uses are social networks (avatar).

#### Symbol









#### Minimum size

To make sure the logo is always clear and legible, there is a minimum size requirement.

A **clear space** is an area surrounding the logo which should be left clear. Placing other graphic elements in this area is forbidden. The clear space is based on the height of the symbol (A).

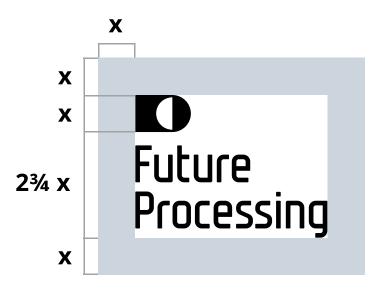
#### **Horizontal version:**

Min. length: 25 mm/116 px Min. height: 3 mm/13 px

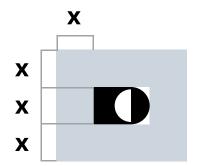


#### Vertical version:

Min. length: 11 mm/64 px Min. height: 8 mm/48 px



**The symbol** does not have a minimum size, however it should be readable.







Whenever possible, use the horizontal version of the logo.



In the second example, the vertical version is used correctly because using the horizontal one would make the logo disproportionately small when compared to others.



In the third example, the symbol is used correctly because there is a company name next to it.

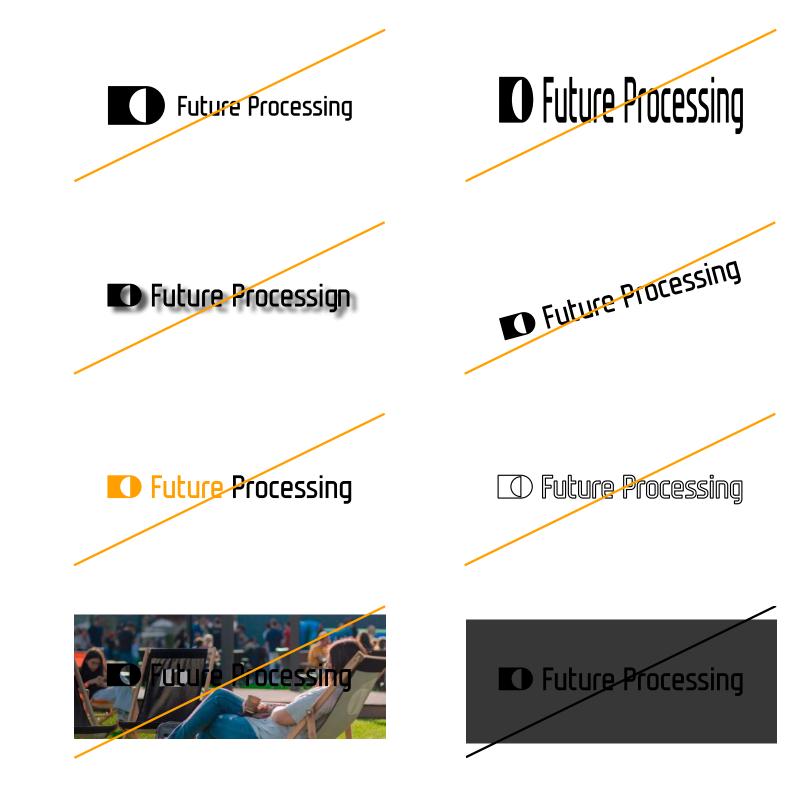






#### It is not allowed to:

- change the size relationship of the components.
- change the proportions of the logo don't stretch or compress it.
- place the logo on a background that distorts its legibility, for example busy photos, patterns, or on colours that provide insufficient contrast.
- add visual effects like shadows, glow, or bold text to the logo. The only exception is a background-coloured shade with very low saturation and a large blur. This effect should be barely noticeable and used solely to enhance the logo's visibility on nonuniform backgrounds.
- place the logo in orientations other than horizontal or vertical.
- change the colours of the logo.
- use the logo as an outline.

#### **Brand Colours**

Consist of a wide set of **oranges**, and two sets of **grays** – cool (with a hint of a blue tone) and regular.

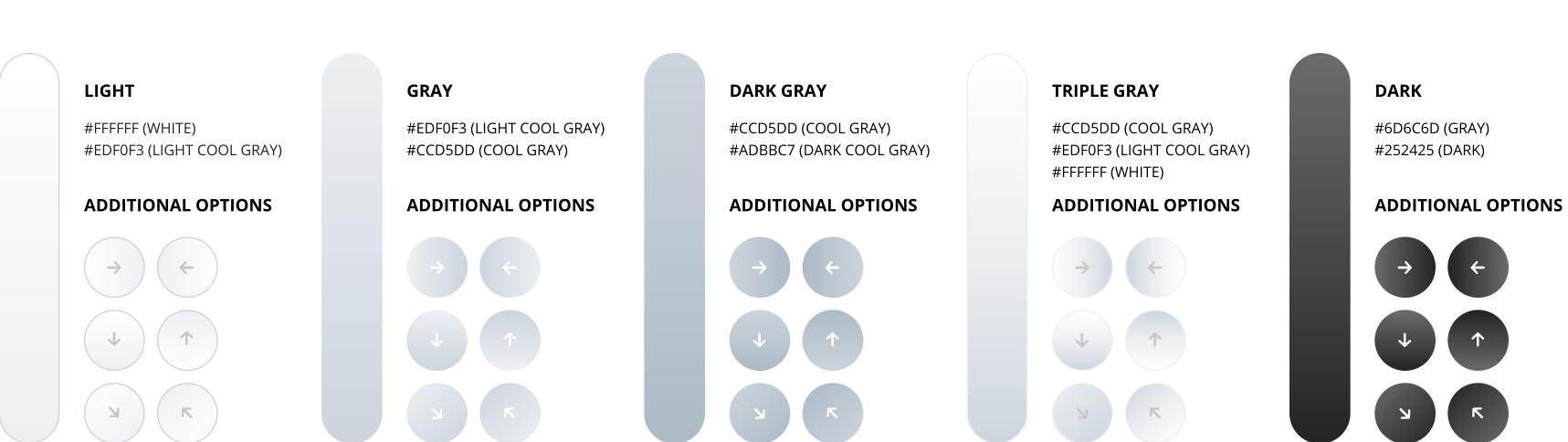




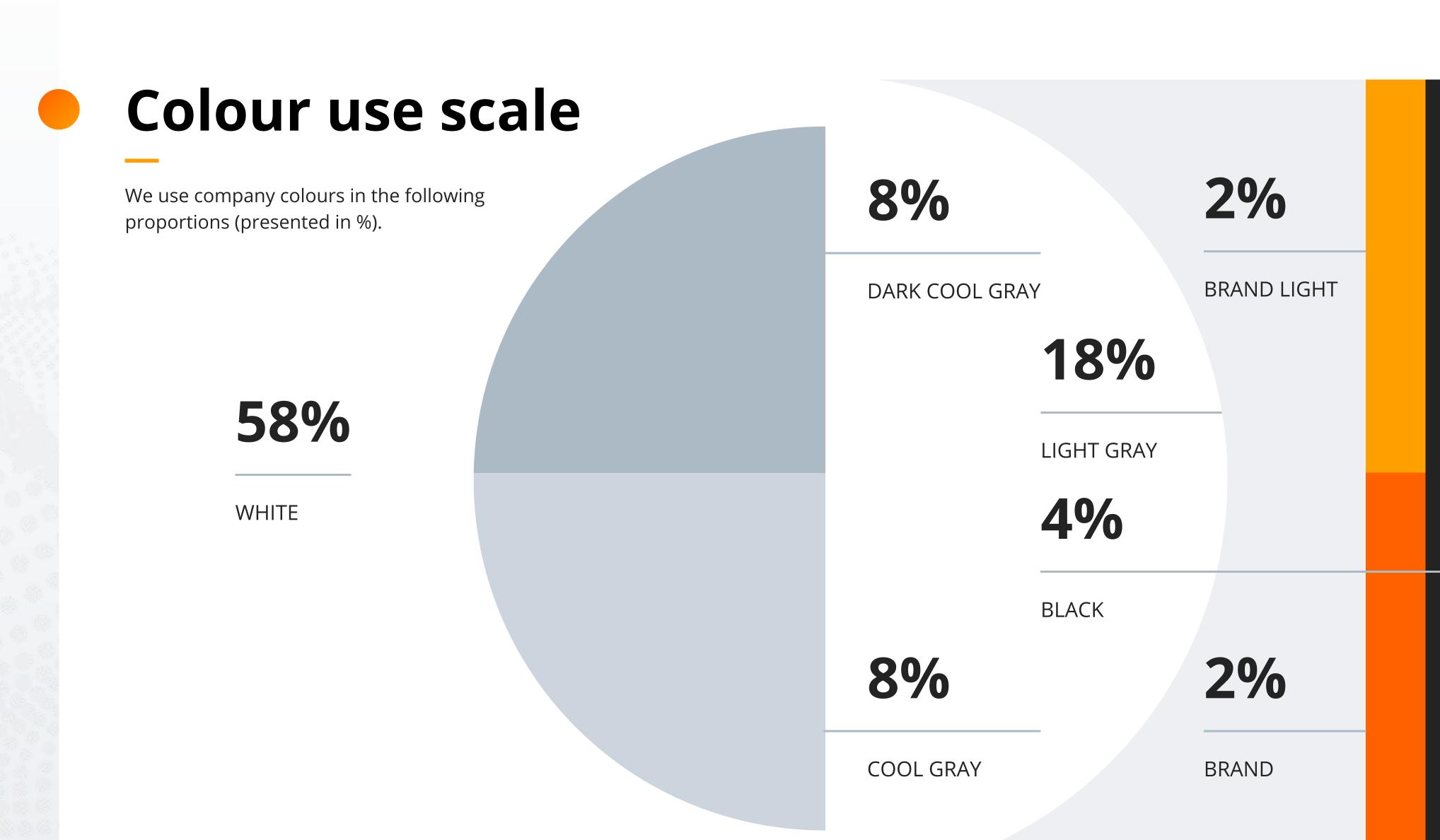
#### Gradients

There are **four types of gradients** in three directions going from light to dark: left to right (horizontal), top to bottom (vertical), and top left to bottom right (diagonal). The direction of the gradients is set by general lighting (coming from the left side).

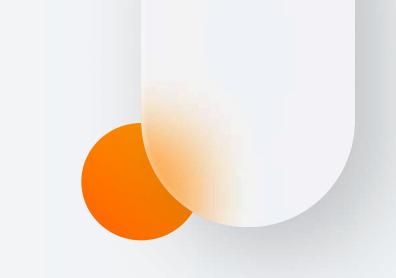

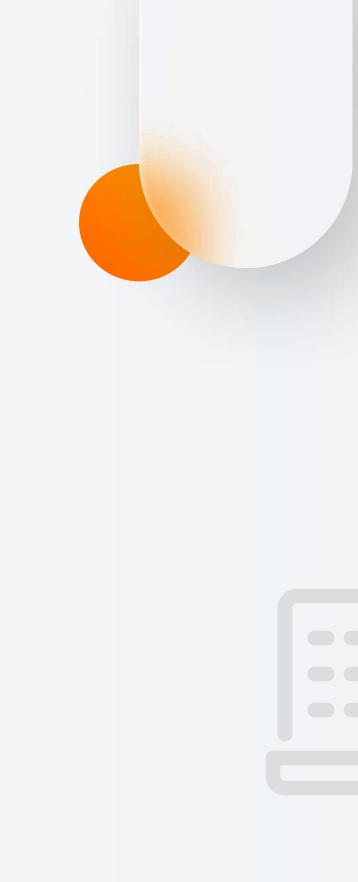

There are two sizes of shadows (regular and small). The direction of the shadows is set by general lighting (coming from the top left side).

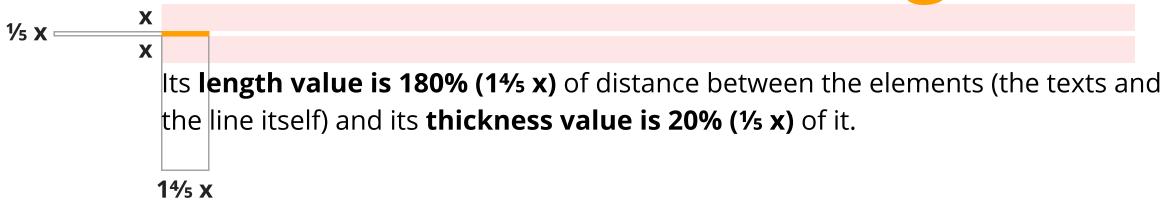






We use a small orange dividing line under headings. It is a separator between the title and the paragraph text.
